MRAQ Club Registration: Information & Form

The Motorcycle Riders Association of Queensland Inc. (MRAQ) is the pinnacle organisation representing Queensland's 125,000+ motorcyclists and motor scooter owners.

Your delegate must then distribute this information to your club as a whole for any comments or action that may be required. It is expected that your delegate will attend the MRAQ monthly meetings to represent your club, obtain information for your members and participate in the decision making process. A replacement delegate can be sent to the meetings if the normal delegate is unavailable to attend. Your clubs voting rights will be transferable to the replacement delegate if the person has been approved to vote on behalf of your club. However this person will not receive personal voting rights unless they become a fully paid member.

By taking part, your club will help support **all** riders by providing the MRAQ with more communications support and bargaining power to assist its lobbying activities.
